Female Teachers dress code for Singapore Amicus International School.

- Comfortable, Neat Clothes: Teachers should wear comfortable clothing 1. that allows easy movement but maintains a professional appearance. This can include well-fitted trousers, blouses, or modest tops.
- No Short Skirts or Dresses: Skirts or dresses should be knee-length or 2. longer to ensure modesty and professionalism.
- 3. Neat Hair: Hair should be clean, well-groomed, and styled in a way that doesn't interfere with teaching.
- **Appropriate Footwear:** Comfortable, closed-toe shoes or sandals with 4. a secure fit are recommended for safety and professionalism. Avoid flipflops or excessively casual footwear.
- Minimal, Tasteful Accessories: Accessories should be simple and not 5. distract from the teaching environment. Avoid large or noisy jewelry.
- Avoid Low-Cut or Tight Clothing: Tops should not be revealing. Avoid 6. wearing tight-fitting or overly casual clothing like leggings (unless paired with a longer tunic or dress).
- Natural Makeup: If makeup is worn, it should be minimal and 7. professional-looking.
- No Graphic Tees or Logos: Clothing should be free from inappropriate 8. slogans, logos, or images.
- **Tattoos:** Visible tattoos should be covered while teaching. 9.
- 10. Cultural Sensitivity: In Cambodia, modesty is highly valued. Ensure clothing respects local traditions and cultural expectations.

Male Teachers dress code for Singapore Amicus International School.

- No Face Jewelry: No facial piercings are allowed (including nose, 1. eyebrow, ears or lip piercings).
- **Shirts:** Neat, collared shirts in neutral colors (white, light blue, beige, etc.) 2. should be worn. Only school-issued golf shirts or t-shirts are permitted for informal school days or events. Shirts should be properly tucked in at all times for a professional appearance.
- 3. Pants: Neat, long pants (chinos, dress pants) are required. No jeans, cargo pants, or shorts are allowed unless specifically permitted for special events.
- **Shoes:** Professional-looking shoes must be worn (loafers, dress shoes, or 4. smart casual shoes). No sandals or slippers.
- 5. Hair: Neat, short hair that is well-groomed. Facial hair should be trimmed and clean if worn.
- Personal Grooming: Maintain a clean and fresh appearance. Personal 6. hygiene must be prioritized (e.g., clean fingernails, fresh breath, appropriate use of deodorant). Minimal, conservative use of cologne or fragrances.
- Accessories: Belts should match shoes for a polished look. Avoid flashy 7. or distracting accessories (e.g., loud ties, oversized jewelry).
- **Tattoos:** Visible tattoos should be covered while teaching. 8.
- 9. General Conduct: Always maintain a professional demeanor and appearance, as teachers are role models for students. Clothing should be clean, pressed, and free from tears or damage.
